The Life Science Alliance Brandenburg-Berlin is a cooperation network funded by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy within the framework of the Central Innovation Program. The network management is located at Brandenburg Invest.

The focus of the network is on life sciences, especially on medical technology and eHealth. The goal is to quickly turn innovative life science ideas into marketable products to improve medical care.

The network consists of small and medium-sized companies, hospitals, universities/research institutes, associated partners and cooperation partners in Germany and abroad as well as larger companies.



As part of this project, funded by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy, LAB-B is also establishing a life science fund.

Its special feature is that the economic development boards of different regions work together to generate the deal flow, to enable rapid market entry for innovation in the countries of the D-A-CH region (Germany-Austria-Switzerland) and its cooperating countries, and that the respective state subsidies can be used for Private-public partnerships.
